## **Tip of the Month:**

Bill S

Using the Cast OG and Fluke

- Cast OG

15lb Fluoro

Better visibility add a prism strip to the side

Higher Gear Ratio reel to get proper action (7:1 or higher)

- Fluke

10-12lb Fluoro leader attached to 15-25lb Braid

Use 4/0 or 5/0 EWG (can add stinger hook..... size 5 treble)

Cast it out and make short/quick twitches
