## **Tips:**

Ethan spoke on a Japanese Technique: Mid Strolling

- Kyoya Fujita won Bassmaster Elite using this technique

-Med Light Rod rigged with 1/8 ball jighead (Kietech)

-DEPS Sakamata Shad 5" Heavy

-Shake the rod w/loose line side to side as you slowly reel, that makes the bait rock side to side in the water

When fishing out of town and staying at a Hotel/Motel, ensure that ALL people are accounted for BEFORE leaving for the boat ramp.
